

 CAPACITY ADDITION OF 30,000 MW FROM WIND BY 2032

RAJYA SABHA

Integrated Energy Policy has projected capacity addition of 30,000 MW from wind by the year 2032. This would be a major part of realizable potential and road map to achieve the wind power potential of the country. The Government put efforts to promote setting up of commercial wind power projects through private sector investments with number of incentives. Besides, wind power is being given preferential tariff in potential states. The Center for Wind Energy technology, Chennai also identifies new wind power potential areas through wind resource assessment studies.

Upward revision of the potential of wind energy would depend upon identification of new wind power potential areas.
